



The Little Green Baby

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Materials:

Use any yarn and gauge as you would like. This only affects the size of the doll. Make sure your needle matches the yarn you use. I used:

US 6 - Double point needles

US 6 – Circular Needles used in the coat

US J- Crochet Hook to make the Magic Loop

150 yards of a Heavy worsted yarn we made and dyed in a light green (800 ypp) or 200 yards= 4 oz

150 yards of a Heavy worsted yarn we made and dyed in tan (800 ypp) or 200 yards= 4 oz

1 ball of fingering weight brushed mohair, for the coat – you will only need about 30 yards

2- 20 mm eyes (optional) you can embroider the eyes

5- 20 mm doll joints (optional) you can just sew the pieces together

Stuffing- either polyester or wool

Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

Increase : chose from one of the following increases

- KFB – knit in the front and back of the stitch.
- M 1 – knit a stitch from the row below and then knit the stitch

K2tog – Knit 2 stitches together

I knit the head , arms and legs before making the body to it is easy to attach them to the body at the same time. I also had a hard time using a doll joint for the head only and sewed the head to secure it more to the body. Maybe a larger doll joint would have worked.

Directions:

Child Head: knit from top to neck

- Using Magic CO- make 6 stitches
- Row1- 2 Knit
- Row 3 Increase in each stitch (12 stitches)
- Row 4 -5 Knit
- Row 6 *K1, Increase one* (18 stitches)
- Row 7 -8 Knit
- Row 9 – *K2, Increase one* (24 stitches)
- Row 10 -11 Knit
- Row 12- *Knit 3, Increase* all around (30 stitches)
- Row13 -14 Knit
- Row 15 *Knit 4, Increase* all around (36 stitches)
- Row 16-17 Knit
- Row 18 *Knit 5, Increase* all around (42 stitches)
- Row 19-23 Knit (5 rows)
- Row 24 Knit 17, through next stitch place a yarn marker, knit 8, in next stitch



place a yarn marker, Knit 17 (this is to mark the eye placement) If you have stitch markers even better! Use in place of the yarn marker.

- Rows 25 -28 Knit (4 rows)
- Row 29 (*Knit 2, Increase* 5 times)
- K1, M1, K8 ,(* Increase 1- 2 times*) , K8, M1, K1
- (*Increase 1, K2 *- 5 times) (these are the cheek increases) (56 sts)
- Rows 30 – 36 Knit (7 rows)
- Row 37 (*K2, K2tog* - 5 times) (*K2tog*- 2 times) K8, (*K2tog*- 2 times)
- (*K2, K2tog* - 5 times) (42 stitches)
- Rows 38 –41 Knit (4 rows)
- Row 42 *Knit 5, K2tog* all around (36 stitches)
- Row 43 Knit
- Row 44 *Knit 4, K2tog* all around (30 stitches)
- Row 45 Knit
- Row 46 *Knit 3, K2tog* all around (24 stitches)
- Row 47 Knit

Child Head: PAGE 2

Attach eyes- adding a piece of white or ecru felt , cut a in the shape and a bit larger than the eye. This will make a softer look to the doll. Begin to stuff the head firmly

- Row 48 *Knit 2, K2tog* all around (18 stitches)
- Row 49 *Knit1, K2tog* all around (12 stitches)
- Row 50 * K2tog* all around (6 stitches)

Insert doll joint if using one and finish stuffing- fasten off all 6 stitches and weave in ends.



Legs (make 2)

knitting from the feet up and stuffing as you go

Using a magic loop cast on 6 stitches

- Row 1- Knit
- Row 2 – Increase in each stitch (12 stitches)
- Row 3 - Knit
- Row 4 – *Knit 1, increase one, Knit 1* all around (18 stitches)
- Row 5 - Knit
- Row 6- *Knit 2, increase one, Knit 2* all around (24 stitches)
- Row 7 - Knit
- Row 8- For the toes:
 - Knit 2, make one bobble,
 - Knit 2 in back of stitches then, make one bobble,
 - Knit 2 in back of stitches then, make one bobble,
 - How to make this bobble:
 - Knit in the front and back of the same stitch 4 times (8 st)
 - Turn – Purl all 8 stitches
 - Turn- Knit all 8 stitches
 - Turn – Purl all 8 stitches
 - Turn – Knit
 - With the stitches on the right needle- use the left needle and Passover 2 stitches over the 1st stitch 3 times, then Passover the last stitch until one remain.
- Row 9 Knit, (knitting in the back of the 1st 11 stitches)
- Rows 10 -13 Knit (4 rows)
- Row 14 Knit 10, (*K1tog* 2 times), K2, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K1 (20 stitches)
- Row 15-16 Knit
- Row 17 K2, *K2tog , K 12, K2tog, K2 (18 stitches)
- Rows 18- 35 Knit – stuffing as you go (18 rows)
- Row 36 Knit 3, K2tog, K4, k2tog, K3, K2tog, K2 (15 stitches)
- Row 37 Knit
- Row 38 (*K1, K2tog* 5 times) (10 stitches)
 - Place a doll joint if using one. Make sure leg is stuffed well
- Row 39 (*Knit 2 tog* 5 times) (5 stitches)

Take a needle and using an 8- 12” tail, go through all 5 stitches, pull tight and weave in ends.

Make sure your doll joints are placed on opposite sides of the top of the leg- one for the right and one for the left. You can also place a circle cardboard in the bottom of the foot for more shape.



Arms (make 2) knitting from the shoulder down and stuffing as you go

Using a magic loop cast on 5 stitches

- Row1- Knit
- Row 2 – Increase in each stitch (10 stitches)
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 Increase in each stitch (15 stitches)
- Row 5 - 18 Knit (if you are placing a doll joint , place it in row 5 - stuff lightly (K 14 rows)

The next rounds are the inside of the arm- increases shape the arm a little

- Row 19 K1, increase 1 stitch, Knit to the end of row (16 stitches)
- Row 20-21 Knit
- Row 22 K1, increase 1 stitch, Knit to the end of row (17 stitches)
- Rows 23-24 Knit
- Row 25 K1, *increase 1 stitch, Knit to end of row (18 stitches)
- Rows 26-27 Knit

Divide stitches equally on three needles to make the fingers. 6 stitches per needle

- Row 28
 - Knit 6 stitches. - Turn
 - Purl 6 stitches - Turn
 - Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times.
 - K2tog 3 times (3 stitches)
 - Pass 2nd stitch over the 1st stitch until one stitch, Pull through , stuff lightly and sew closed.
 - Make 2 more fingers and sew any holes in the middle



Body knitting from the neck down and stuffing as you go

Using a magic loop cast on 12 stitches

- Row 1- Knit
- Row 2 – *K1, increase 1* 6 times (18 stitches)
- Row 3 - Knit
- Row 4 – *K2, increase 1* 6 times (24 stitches)
- Row 5 - Knit
- Row 6- *Knit 2, increase one, (*Knit 3, increase one* 5 times),K1 (30 stitches)
- Row 7 - Knit
- Row 8 *K4, increase 1* 6 times (36 stitches)
- Rows 9-13 Knit
- Row 14 This row is the arm placement
 - K9, place yarn marker in between stitches or if you have stitch markers even better!, K18, place yarn or stich marker in between stitches, K9
- Row 15 Knit
- Row 16 (*K3, increase stitch* 9 times (45 stitches)
- Row 17-21 Knit (5 rows)
- Row 22 K1 (*increase 1, k2* - 2 times),
 - Increase 1, K1
 - Increase 1, K2
 - Increase 1, k19
 - Increase 1, K2
 - Increase 1, K1
 - (*increase 1, k2* - 2 times),
 - Increase 1, K2 (55 stitches)
- Rows 23-30 Knit (8 rows)
- Row 31 K 27, K2tog, K26 (54 stitches)
- Rows 32- 36 Knit (5 rows)
- Row 37 (This is where the Leg doll joint placing is)
 - K15, place a yarn or stitch marker between stitches
 - K24, place a yarn or stitch marker between stitches
 - K15
- Row 38 Knit
- Row 39 (* K2, K2tog*- 3 times)
 - K8, K2tog,
 - K10, K2tog,
 - K8 K2tog,
 - K10 (48 stitches)
- Row 40 Knit
- Row 41 K1, (*K2tog*- 3 times),
 - K1, K2tog,
 - K6, K2tog,
 - K10 K2tog,
 - K6, k2tog,
 - (*k2, K2tog* 2 times) , K2 (39 stitches)
- Row 42 Knit

Ears Make 2

Cast On 30 Stitches, I use a long tail cast on, but use the one you like

- Rows 1- 14 Knit (14 rows)
- Row 15 (*K4, K2tog*) 5 times (25 stitches)
- Rows 16- 18 Knit
- Row 19 (*K3, K2tog*) all around (20 stitches)
- Rows 20-22 Knit
- Row 23 K2tog, K16, K2tog (18 stitches)
- Rows 24-27 Knit
- Row 28 K2tog, K14, K2tog (16 stitches)
- Rows 29-31 Knit
- Row 32 K2 tog, K2, K2tog, K4, K2tog, k2, k2tog (12 stitches)
- Rows 33-34 Knit
- Row 35 K2tog, K3, K2tog, K3, K2tog (9 stitches)
- Rows 36- 37 Knit
- Row 38 K2tog, K2, K2tog, K1, K2tog (6 stitches)
- Row 39 Knit
- Row 40 K2tog, K2, K2tog (4 stitches)
- Row 41 K2tog 2 times (2 stitches)
- Row 42 Pass 2nd stich on hook over the 1st one, pull through and leave a long tail.

Fold this piece in half. Starting at the tip of the ear, sew the edge toward the base of the ear. Turn inside out. Take the seam and fold it towards the middle and the other edge and fold it in. Sew 1 or two stitches to hold it together, being careful not to sew both layers together. This will form the inside of the ear and help it to stand. You can knit these ears in the round, but they look better knit flat and sewn in my honest opinion.

Sew to head with the ears pointing down (or up, whichever you prefer) – sew ear layer separately going around the bottom of the ear. see photos.

Here is the one or two stitches at the bottom to form the inside and create stability.



Ear attached to the head

COAT PAGE 2

- Row 28 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 29 K4, K2, (*K6, Increase a stitch* - 6 times), K2, K4 (60 stitches)
- Row 30 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 31 Knit
- Row 32 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 33 K4, K2, (*K7, increase stitch* - 6 times), K2, K4 (66 stitches)
- Row 34 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 35 Knit
- Row 36 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 37 K4, K2, (*K8, increase stitch* - 6 times), K2, K4 (72 stitches)
- Row 38 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 39 Knit
- Row 40 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 41 K4, K2, (*K9, increase stitch* - 6 times), K2, K4 (78 stitches)
- Row 42 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 43 Knit
- Row 44 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 45 K4, K2, (*K10, increase stitch* - 6 times), K2, K4 (84 stitches)

Knit the next two rows until piece measures ½ inch from the top of the feet

- Row 54 K4, Purl between markers, K4
- Row 55 to end Knit

Last 4 rows

Knit – creating a garter stitch border.

Bind off and weave in ends.

Sleeves -

Pick up 22 stitches around the arm holes in the jacket

Knit in the round for 15 rows or until desired length to end of arm.

Add Fuzzy yarn used in the collar and

(*Purl 1 round, Knit 1 round* 5 times)

Bind off and weave in ends.

Repeat for other arm.

Little Baby's Frog named Fred

Quick and easy frog – he can sit by himself if positioned

Materials:

- Set of Double Point Knitting Needles in correct size for yarn. (I used a US 5)
- Worsted Weight Yarn in green, about 50 yards
- Worsted Weight Yarn in yellow, about 10 yards
- Worsted Weight Yarn in white about 1 – 2 yards
- Polyfill or wool to stuff
- One pair of 6 mm black safety eyes
- Tapestry Needle
- Stitch marker

Abbreviations:

- K = Knit
- P = Purl
- St = stitch
- KFB = Knit in the front and back of the same stitch
- Inc 1 = either knit in the front and back of the same stitch or
 - Make 1(M1) Knitting 1 stitch from the row below one stitch and knit that stitch
- W/T = Wrap and turn.
 - Knit rows: With yarn in front , slip one stitch to right hand needle, place yarn in back and return stitch to the left hand needle.
 - Purl rows: With yarn in back , slip one stitch to right hand needle, place yarn in front and return stitch to the left hand needle.
- PSSO – Pass Slipped Stitches over the Knitted Stitch = a decrease

Head:

Top part of the head using green

- Using Magic Circle- cast on 6 Stitches
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 KFB all around (12 stitches)
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 (*K1, Inc 1*) 6 times (18 stitches)
- Row 5 Knit
- Row 6 (*K2, Inc 1*) 6 times (24 stitches)
- Rows 7-9 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 10 K10, W/T next stitch,
 - ❖ Turn and P6 st, W/T next stitch.
 - ❖ Turn, K5, W/T next stitch
 - ❖ Turn, P3, W/T next stitch
 - ❖ Turn, K and work each wrapped stitches to the end.
- Row 11 Knit and work the wrapped stitches from previous round
- Row 12 Bind Off Loosely



Bottom part of the head using orange or yellow or whatever color you choose

- Using Magic Circle- cast on 6 Stitches
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 KFB all around (12 stitches)
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 (*K1, Inc 1*) 6 times (18 stitches)
- Row 5 Knit
- Row 6 (*K2, Inc 1*) 6 times (24 stitches)
- Rows 7-9 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 10 Bind Off Loosely

With wrong sides together , sew the bottom and top of the head together



These photos show how to sew the pieces together. Make sure the green is sewn over the gold so the face is correct.



The Body - from the bottom up

- Using Magic Circle- cast on 6 Stitches
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 KFB all around (12 stitches)
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 (*K1, Inc 1*) 6 times (18 stitches)
- Row 5 Knit
- Row 6 (*K2, Inc 1*) 6 times (24 stitches)
- Rows 7-9 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 10 (* K6, K2tog*) 3 times (21 stitches)
- Rows 11 – 13 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 14 (* K5, K2tog*) 3 times (18 stitches)
- Rows 15- 17 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 18 (* K7, K2tog*) 2 times (16 stitches)
- Rows 19- 21 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 22 Bind off loosely
- Sew head to body making sure the short row head stitches face towards tummy.

The Belly - Sewn on afterwards

- Cast on 5 Stitches (knit flat)
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 Purl
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 Purl
- Row 5 K1, Inc 1, K1, Inc 1, K1 (7 stitches)
- Row 6 Purl
- Row 7 Knit
- Rows 8 Purl
- Row 9 K1, Inc.1, K1, Inc.1, K1, Inc.1, K1 (10 stitches)
- Rows 10 Purl
- Row 11 Knit
- Rows 12 Purl
- Row 13 K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K1 (7 stitches)
- Rows 14 Purl
- Row 15 K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K1 (5 stitches)
- Row 16 Bind Off and sew to body



Legs (make 2) from bottom up

- Cast on 22 Stitches , join and knit in the round
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 Purl
- Row 3 K4, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K8, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K4 (18 stitches)
- Row 4 Knit
- Row 5 K3, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K6, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K3 (14 stitches)
- Row 6 Knit
- Row 7 K2, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K4, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K2 (10 stitches)
- Row 8 Knit
- Row 9 K1, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K2, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K1 (6stitches)
- Row 10-15 Knit (6 Rounds)
- Row 16 K1, Inc 1, K2, Inc 1, K1 (8 stitches)
- Row 17-19 Knit (3 rounds)
- Row 20 (*K1, Inc 1*) 4 times (12 stitches)
- Row 21-32 Knit (12 rounds)
- Rows 33 (*K2tog, K4*) 2 times 10 Stiches)
- Row 34 Knit
- Row 35 (*K2tog, K2, K2tog*) 2 times (6 stitches)
- Row 36 Cut an 8-12" tail, thread through all stitches and pull tight. Sew to body

<p>Take a few tuck stitches in the foot and ankle to make it make a bend.</p>		<p>Above all – customize to the way you want.</p>



Arms (make 2) from bottom up

- Cast on 14 Stitches , join and knit in the round
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 Purl
- Row 3 K3, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K6, Slip2, K1, PSSO,K3 (14 stitches)
- Row 4 Knit
- Row 5 K2, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K4, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K2 (10 stitches)
- Row 6 Knit
- Row 7 K1, Slip 2, K1, PSSO, K2, Slip2, K1, PSSO, K1 (6 stitches)
- Row 8-19 Knit (12 Rounds)
- Row 20 (*K2tog, K2, K2tog*) 2 times (6 stitches)
- Row 21 Cut an 8-12" tail, thread through all stitches and pull tight.

Sew to body

Eyes (make 2) from eye white to green

- Using Magic Circle- cast on 5 Stitches with white yarn
- Row 1 Knit
- Row 2 KFB all around (10 Stitch)
- Row 3 Knit
- Row 4 Attach green yarn and Knit one round
- Row 5 Knit
 - Attach a 8 mm eye in the middle of the Cast On if using them
- Row 6-7 Knit (2 rounds)
- Row 8 K2, K2tog,K2,K2tog, K2 (8 stitches)
- Row 9 Knit
- Row 10 K2tog around (4 Stitches)
-

Cut yarn leaving a 14" tail. Stuff eye lightly and thread through all stitches and pull tight.

			<p>Sew to head and insert needle through the face to the chin.</p>
<p>Push the eyeball inside and take a running stitch around to hold so you do not have bug eyes.</p>	<p>Pull taught to make the face hold its position.</p>
